

CRITERIA FOR CARBON BUILDERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants must be a student or a graduate of one of the five high schools in Carbon County, Pennsylvania. Those schools being defined as Lehighton, Palmerton, Jim Thorpe, Panther Valley, and Weatherly.

Applicant will attend an accredited college, university, technical college or approved apprenticeship program and major in one of the construction fields.

Applicant must show evidence of acceptance to State certified or approved trade school or other post high school technical school, and must concentrate their studies in the fields of **electrical, plumbing, heating ventilation and air conditioning, carpentry, architecture, drafting, engineering etc.** as it pertains to the building industry.

Applicants will submit a completely filled in copy of the accompanying application to the guidance office of their respective high school or mail to: Carbon Builders Association, P.O. Box 218, 490 Ore Street, Bowmanstown, PA 18030.

Along with the application and transcript the applicants shall submit a short, 300 word or less explanation as to why they have chosen this field of study and how they intend to use the scholarship proceeds should they be granted. This explanation shall be in a typed form on 8.5 x 11 inch, white unlined paper.

All Applications are due not later than April 30th, 2019.

All Applicants, and their applications, will be reviewed by the Carbon Builders Association (CBA) Board of Directors and the recipient(s) shall be decided upon by the CBA Board of Directors.

Monetary Distribution of Scholarship will be to the Applicant be awarded the scholarship.
